FREMONT INVITATIONAL --

We are happy to invite you to the Fremont Invitational. We feel that our golf course, of 6,532 yards, par 71, 18 holes, is one of the finest in the state. We trust after playing it, you will feel the same.

ENTRY --

Spots are reserved on a "first come, first served" basis. Please return your entry without delay and no later than June 1, 2010. We are always trying to upgrade and update our invitation list. TOURNAMENT PLAY --

All players will qualify over 18 holes on Saturday. After qualifying, the field will be divided into a championship flight and three to five other flights, depending upon the number of entries, of about 25-35 players in each.

On Sunday, the championship flight and other flights will play 18 holes. The winners will be determined by their total score for both days.

PAIRINGS AND STARTING TIMES --

All players on Saturday may start between 7:30 and 9:30 A.M. or between 12:00 and

2:00 P.M. After this time, the course will be open to members of the Fremont Golf Club for play. Sunday tee off times will be posted Saturday night and will be on the FGC website. Sunday tee times will begin at 7:30 A.M.

*PRIZES --

Continuing the tradition of keeping the Fremont Invitational one of the top amateur tournaments in the state, the Tournament Committee intends to pay prizes to approximately 30% of the field. With a full field, prizes should exceed \$10,000.

Championship Flight -- The top fifteen to twenty players will receive prizes in the form of gift certificates in value from \$750.00 down to \$100.00. Champion will also receive a beautiful trophy.

Flights -- The top nine to twelve players in each flight will receive prizes in the form of gift certificates.

ENTRY FEE --

The \$115.00 entry fee will include a **free practice round** on Friday, the **two days of Tournament play**, and **two passes for lunch** on Saturday and Sunday. Extra lunch passes may be purchased for \$12.50. We are no longer including dinner Saturday night, but players are welcome to dine at the Club at their own expense.
